## **Connecticut Alliance to End Sexual Violence, Inc. Clinical Services & Standards Coordinator**

The Alliance is the statewide coalition of sexual assault crisis service programs working to end sexual violence through victim assistance, community education, and public policy advocacy. The Alliance's mission is to end sexual violence and ensure high quality, comprehensive, and culturally competent sexual assault victim services.

The Clinical Services & Standards Coordinator is a full time position with benefits. The position reports to the Associate Director.

The Clinical Services & Standards Coordinator is responsible for the ongoing clinical supervision of The Alliance's Post-conviction Victim Services team, clinical support and technical assistance for sexual assault advocates across the state, and ongoing promotion and assurance of The Alliance's Standards for Sexual Assault Crisis Programs.

### **Specific Duties Include:**

- Provide technical assistance and clinical support, both in groups and one-on-one, to sexual assault victim advocates working with survivors with heightened or multiple needs
- Plan and hold monthly statewide case management meetings for The Alliance's Post-conviction Victim Services team
- Provide support, technical assistance, and training to sexual assault advocates providing both individual short-term supportive counseling and facilitating support groups in order to bolster advocates' skills in providing high quality, trauma-informed services
- Outreach to other service providers throughout the state of Connecticut including, but not limited to, mental health, addiction, and clinical program staff in order to create a coordinated system of referrals
- Facilitate The Alliance's Victim/Survivor Advisory Council (VSAC) including hosting quarterly meetings, working to grow and diversify membership, increase group participation and investment in the work of The Alliance, and provide ongoing support to group members
- Coordinate the ongoing review of member center service standards, and support the Associate Director and Executive Director in the coordination of annual member center site visits to ensure quality of service delivery

- In coordination with the Data and Reporting Coordinator, provide ongoing quarterly and annual analysis of client feedback surveys and coordinate efforts to ensure that all member programs meet an organizational threshold
- Other duties as assigned

**Qualifications and Required Skills:**

- MSW or similar degree required
- Demonstrated understanding of and commitment to anti-violence issues and violence against women issues
- Successful experience in entering new and diverse communities and building collaborative relationships
- Experience in coordinating and facilitating meetings
- Excellent oral and written communication skills
- Demonstrated ability to handle and prioritize multiple projects
- Reliable transportation
- Ability to work some nights and weekends
