Child Advocate Full-Time/Benefit Eligible

The YWCA Sexual Assault Crisis Service is seeking a full time (40 hours) Child Advocate. This position provides counseling and advocacy to children who are survivors of sexual violence as well as their loved ones. This position also provides presentations, outreach, and intervention services to underserved populations in targeted communities in the New Britain region. Candidates must have reliable transportation, enabling them to travel on a daily basis. Candidate will have on-call responsibilities and will work select holidays, evenings, and weekends, as necessary.

Applicants must be self-starters, highly organized, and have a strong knowledge of issues related to sexual violence. State certification as a Sexual Assault Crisis Counselor is strongly preferred; applicants without a current certification will be required to obtain certification within 3 months of employment. Applicants must hold a minimum of a Bachelor's degree in Social Work, Psychology, or a related field. This position is full-time and benefit eligible.
