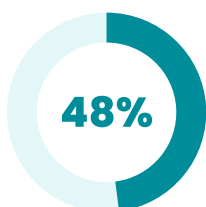

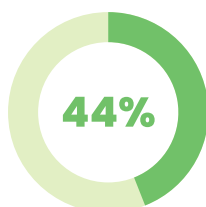
In 2021, the CT LGBTQ+ Justice and Opportunity Network conducted a survey to better-understand the experiences and needs of LGBTQ+ adults living in Connecticut.

Of all 3,048 survey respondents in CT, **34%** of LGBTQ+ adults report being a victim or survivor of sexual violence.

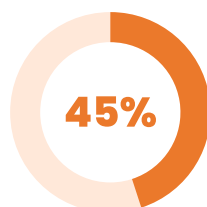
Data analysis highlight that certain communities experience sexual violence at higher rates than others.



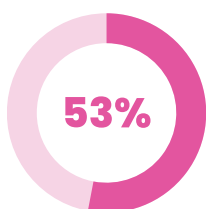
48% of Black LGBTQ+ adults report that they have experienced sexual violence



44% of bisexual adults report that they have experienced sexual violence



45% of transgender / nonbinary adults report that they have experienced sexual violence



53% of LGBTQ+ adults report that they have experienced some form of violence specifically as a result of their gender or sexual identity
